### MARCH BREAKFAST EDUCATIONAL SEMINAR



Linda Bergeland, Manager, Small Business development and Mail Acceptance, Great Lakes Area presented a very helpful program about the benefits of Seamless Acceptance (SA) at the March Breakfast Seminar. SA is providing mailers a streamlined process that eliminates acceptance barriers and offers transparency and trend-based quality reporting over a calendar month. SA automates and simplifies the entry, verification and induction of commercial mail at both Business Mail Acceptance Units and Detached Mail Units. Linda walked the audience through the process and outlined some best practices. She explained Seamless Parallel and how it is an intermediate step mailers must take before fully participating in SA.

Great Lakes Area Manager of Marketing Michael McInturf began the presentation by explaining the benefits of SA and how it is getting all of us on the same platform.



### 2020 NATIONAL POSTAL FORUM CANCELED

The National Postal Forum (NPF) and the United States Postal Service leadership have been closely monitoring the situation related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) over the past several weeks with the health and safety of our employees and attendees as the priority. We have been taking our guidance from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and public health departments. The CDC issued the following statement on Sunday, March 15th -

"Therefore, CDC, in accordance with its guidance for large events and mass gatherings, recommends that for the next 8 weeks, organizers (whether groups or individuals) cancel or postpone in-person events that consist of 50 people or more throughout the United States."

As a result of this guidance and out of an abundance of caution, we are canceling the 2020 National Postal Forum.

Thank you to the NPF and USPS community, partners, exhibitors, vendors, and volunteers who have dedicated so much time and work into preparing this meeting. We share everyone's disappointment in its cancellation.

This unprecedented action has resulted in a few logistical items, which are outstanding and will be resolved.

Please save the date for the 2021 National Postal Forum scheduled for May 2 - 5, 2021 in Nashville, TN.




